

DURHAM COUNTY JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCIL
GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE
AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Durham, through the Parks and Recreation Department, has been awarded a grant from the Durham County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council

WHEREAS, the City has a goal of preventing teen gang activity by directing youth toward positive activities available in the City of Durham,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The project authorized is the Project M.O.R.E. (Maximized - Outreach – Redirection – Enrichment) for the period of July 1, 2007 - June 30, 2008.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the Durham County Juvenile Crime Prevention Council to undertake the project.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:
