

2011 TARGET GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Durham, through the Durham Police Department, has been awarded a Target grant to support the Durham Police Department’s Crime Victim’s Rights Week; and

WHEREAS, the grant must be used to support the Durham Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM THAT:

Section 1. The grant project is authorized to support the Police Department’s Crime Victim’s Right Week with the purchase of educational/promotional materials, advertisement; victim empowerment events, training and the banquet associated with activities during that week and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the Target grant and to undertake the project.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete this project:
