**CITY OF DURHAM AND US DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - FEDERAL TRANSIT  
ADMINISTRATION – SECTION 5316, JOB ACCESS REVERSE COMMUTE (JARC) FUNDS GRANT  
PROJECT ORDINANCE AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for the Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking of City staff; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM** that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following Grant Project Ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1. The ordinance is a grant project ordinance concerning the JARC grant funds, as described in the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO) Coordinated Public Transit - Human Services Transportation Plan, Program Management Plan and DATA and Chapel Hill Transit JARC projects, and will be valid until completion of the grant projects or funds are expended.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive planning Grant for the JARC funds project. The JARC Grant funding will be used in conjunction with financing allocated within the state/federal match budget of the Transportation Division.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:

FTA JARC Grant	\$208,807
City of Durham Matching funds	\$109,911
Town of Chapel Hill Matching funds	\$ 84,968
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TOTAL	\$403,686

Section 4. The following amount is appropriated for the project:

City of Durham	\$233,750
Town of Chapel Hill	\$169,936
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TOTAL	\$403,686

Section 5. Within five days after the adoption, the City shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Budget Director, Director of Finance, Accounting Services Manager, and the Transportation Planning Manager. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.
