

**CITY OF DURHAM AND THE CITY OF RALEIGH 2040 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP) SCENARIO PLANNING INITIATIVE**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a grant by the City of Raleigh for the development of the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Scenario Planning Initiative ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking of City staff; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM** that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following Grant Project Ordinance is hereby adopted:

Section 1. The ordinance is a grant project ordinance concerning development of the 2040 LRTP scenario planning initiative, as described in the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO) Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and in the City of Inter-local Agreement, and will be valid until completion of the grant project or until funds are expended.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive planning Grant for the 2040 LRTP Scenario Planning project. The funding will be used in conjunction with financing allocated within the state/federal match budget of the Transportation Department to pay for consulting service associated with the development of the Scenario Planning model.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:

Section 5. Within five days after the adoption, the City shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Budget Director, Director of Finance, Accounting Services Manager, and the Transportation Planning Manager. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
