

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN 300 E. MAIN STREET, LLC AND
THE CITY OF DURHAM FOR BUILDING IMPROVEMENT INCENTIVES FOR
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

This contract amendment ("Amendment") is dated and entered into as of the _____ day of _____, 20_____, between 300 E. Main Street, LLC (hereinafter, the "Company") and City of Durham ("City").

The City and the Company entered into a contract titled "Agreement Between 300 E. Main Street, LLC and the City of Durham for Building Improvement Incentives for Economic Development Activities," dated April 18, 2011. That contract is referred to as the "Original Contract." The Original Contract referenced a completion date of no later than one year following the "Approval Date." The City Council approved the Original Contract on April 18, 2011. The Company will be unable to complete the required work by April 18, 2012 due to negotiations underway with the planned tenant of the ground floor retail area for a redesign of the space to accommodate the tenant's business needs. The Original Contract is hereby amended as follows:

1. In Section 2(a), *Prerequisites to Payments*, after "Qualifying Capital Investment", delete the phrase, "within one year of the Approval Date, for a project begun no later than 9 months following the Approval Date" and insert "no later than August 18, 2012."
