Durham Annual Action Plan “Needs” Public Hearings

A public hearing will be held by the Durham City Council to receive citizen comments on needs in Durham neighborhoods. It is envisioned that these needs will be addressed through the use of federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) Consortium funds, and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds as contained in the upcoming FY 2012-2013 Annual Action Plan. For FY 2012-2013, the City of Durham anticipates receiving approximately \$1.6 million in CDBG funds and approximately \$761,000 in HOME Consortium funds and \$80,000 in Emergency Solutions Grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
