On November 14, 2011, the City of Durham will release applications for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Programs for the FY 2012-2013 period. Due to proposed reductions, the City anticipates receiving approximately \$1.4 million in CDBG funds, \$680,000 in HOME funds, and \$80,000 in ESG funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Supplemental City of Durham general funds may also be available for distribution.

**All applications must be submitted by 2:00 PM on Monday, December 19, 2011.**

**Eligible Applicants.** All applicants must meet the following minimum criteria:

### **HOME:**

- IRS designated 501(c)(3) nonprofit agencies or for-profit corporations with experience in constructing and providing affordable housing to low- and moderate-income families; or
- Nonprofit agencies acting as Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDOs) and recognized as such by the City of Durham.

### **CDBG/ESG**

- IRS designated 501(c)(3) nonprofit agencies or for-profit corporations that have at least one year of experience providing housing, human services or economic development services within the City of Durham; and
- Ability to demonstrate the proposed project meets a National Objective according to 24 CFR 24 570.208.

### **Application Workshop**

Eligible non-profit and business entities interested in applying for assistance are encouraged to attend a workshop discussing the Application process on Monday, November 14, 2011 beginning at 10 AM at the City of Durham's Solid Waste Department's Auditorium located at 1833 Camden Avenue, Durham, NC 27704. Beginning Monday, November 14, the application can be downloaded at <http://www.durhamnc.gov/departments/comdev/> and will be disseminated at this workshop.

Interested applicants may print the application from the City website, complete, and submit it to the Department of Community Development as described in the application. Applicants are invited to contact the Department of Community Development to discuss the eligibility of their application or to obtain technical assistance.
