Executive Summary

In 2000, the Durham City Council and the Durham County Board of Commissioners approved an interlocal agreement to establish the Durham City-County Appearance Commission, in accordance with NCGS 160A-451. This agreement was renewed in 2004 and 2007.

The current interlocal agreement will expire on January 1, 2013. This renewal will continue the interlocal agreement until January 1, 2018, and includes the same renewal interval as previously approved. Other proposed changes to the document modify the wording to be more in keeping with the general statutes regarding local Appearance Commissions.

Recommendation

To approve the revisions to the City-County Appearance Commission Interlocal Agreement.

Alternatives

The City Council could approve, approve with modifications, or deny this request.
