

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EXISTING SECTION 38-21 OF THE DURHAM CITY CODE WHICH REGULATES THE POSSESSION AND COMSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND PARKS**

WHEREAS, the City wishes to allow alcoholic beverages, defined as beer, lager, malt liquor, ale, porter, and any other brewed or fermented beverage containing at least one-half of one percent and not more than 15 percent alcohol by volume at approved areas and facilities, and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to establish an administrative permitting process and regulations concerning the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in public buildings and parks, therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM THAT:

SECTION 1. Part 38-21 (Alcoholic Beverages – Possession and consumption in public buildings and parks) of the Durham City code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the attached Section 38-21 Alcoholic Beverages – Possession and consumption in public buildings and parks.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption.
