

**EPA EMERGING TECHNOLOGY DIESEL REDUCTION GRANT PROJECT
ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham, through the Triangle Clean Cities Coalition, is the sub recipient of a grant from Southern Research Institute and the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency, in the amount of \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, the City values the benefits of improved air quality; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The project described in the agreement executed between Southern Research Institute and the City of Durham is hereby authorized to be undertaken during the contract period of April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011 to install emission-reduction technologies on 16 heavy-duty vehicles/equipment and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the EPA Emerging Technology Diesel Reduction Grant and to undertake the project.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:
