PROJECT ORDINANCE SUPERSEDING GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE –GPO
#14006 AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a grant by the Federal Highway Administration through the North Carolina Department of Transportation for conducting a transportation planning project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking of City staff;

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM THAT:

Section 1. The ordinance is a grant project ordinance concerning a transportation planning Project for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 as described in the Unified Planning Work Program for the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization, fiscal year 2009-2010. Funds are for FY 2009-10 or until project activities are completed and funds are expended.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement and other documents that are required within the terms of the “Disbursement and Accounting of Urban Transportation Planning Funds Appropriated Under Section 104(f), Title 23 United States Code” and the “Disbursement and Accounting of Transportation Funds Appropriated Under Section 133(b)(3)(7), Title 23 United States Code” agreements with the North Carolina Department of Transportation.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to Complete the project:
