

FTA 5307 CMAQ GRANT AND
AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Durham anticipates receiving a Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality (CMAQ) grant from the Federal Transit Administration to use as federal financial assistance to fund the operation of the Bull City Connector Service;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking for the City of Durham;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. This ordinance is a grant project ordinance authorizing this transit project for the Durham transit system beginning on July 1, 2012 until the project is completed.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreements and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the Federal Transit Administration CMAQ operating assistance grant for the operation of the Bull City Connector service.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the City to complete the project:

FTA CMAQ Operating Grant	<u>\$800,000</u>
TOTAL	\$800,000

Section 4. The following amount is available to provide the City match for these grants:

Transfer from Transit Fund	<u>\$200,000</u>
TOTAL	\$200,000

Section 5. The following amount is appropriated:

FY2013- FTA CMAQ Project Ordinance	\$1,000,000
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Section 6. Within five days after the adoption the City Clerk shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Finance Director, Accounting Services Manager, Transportation Director, Assistant Transportation Director (Transit), and the Budget Director. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.
