

**THE UNITED STATES MARSHAL SERVICE (USMS) 2013 EQUIPMENT DONATION
GRANT SUPERCEDING GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE #14450**

Whereas, the City of Durham through the Durham Police Department has been awarded a donation grant from the United States Marshals Service in the amount not to exceed 40,000; and

Whereas, the United States Marshals Service will donate a vehicle and up-fit cost, that will be used for activities involving the USMS Fugitive Apprehension Task Force and approved by the USMS Supervisory Deputy, Chief Deputy, or US Marshal; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The project described in the US Marshals Service MOU is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City of Durham to receive the 2013 USMS Equipment Donation Grant.

Section 3. The following donation is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham for law enforcement purposes:

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Section 4. The following amount is appropriated for this project to be spent in the following manner:

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| 2013 USMS Equipment | \$40,000 |
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Section 5. This ordinance supersedes Grant Project Ordinance # 14450.

Section 6. Within five (5) days after this ordinance is adopted, the City of Durham shall file a copy of the ordinance with the Finance Director, Accounting Services Manager, the Budget Director and the Chief of Police.
