

**AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT #9696
FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES FOR THE
CITY OF DURHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT**

This contract ("Amendment") is dated and entered into as of the 12th day of November 2013, between Law Enforcement Services Group, PLLC d/b/a/ The FMRT Group ("Contractor") and City of Durham ("City").

The City and the contractor entered into a contract titled "Psychological Services of Police Department Employees" dated June 18, 2012. That contract is referred to as the "Original Contract." The Original Contract is hereby amended as follows:

Additional service added to Section 5 (Contractor's Billings to City, Compensation).

Original Contract states:

- (a) \$195 per hour for critical incident activities (consultation, response, debriefing, individual counseling);
- (b) \$195 per hour for fitness-for-duty or fitness-for-assignment evaluations;
- (c) \$195 per hour for individual counseling sessions;
- (d) \$195 per hour for training and training consultations; and
- (e) \$195 per hour for consultation or participation in department requested activities.

Change:

Add (f): \$310 per each Annual Psychological Evaluation for SET and SVU Team Members.

Add (scope of work): The Police Department has employees assigned to specialized assignments and teams. These employees may be exposed to work stressors beyond that of other employees. Employees who are assigned to certain specialized teams may have annual psychological evaluations with FMRT Psychologists in order to assess ongoing suitability for the position(s) and to identify any barriers to continued assignment.

These psychological evaluations will be specific to the specialized assignment. The employees will be scheduled on an annual basis according to their hire date. The Police Department will be responsible for informing The FMRT Group of any personnel changes to their rosters.

Section _____. E-Verify Compliance. The contractor represents and covenants that the contractor and its subcontractors comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes (NCGS). In this E-Verify Compliance section, "contractor": "its subcontractors," and "comply" shall have the meanings intended by NCGS 160A-20.1(b). The City is relying on this section in entering into this contract. The parties agree to this section only to the extent authorized by law. If this section is held to be unenforceable or invalid in whole or in part, it shall be deemed amended to the extent necessary to make this contract comply with NCGS 160A-20.1(b).
