

**CITY OF DURHAM AND US DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION – FEDERAL TRANSIT
ADMINISTRATION – FY 2013 SECTION 5317, NEW FREEDOM FUNDS GRANT PROJECT
ORDINANCE SUPERSEDING GPO #14532 AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT
AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a grant by the Federal Highway Administration through the North Carolina Department of Transportation for conducting a transportation planning project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and Desirable undertaking of City staff; now therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM THAT:

Section 1. The ordinance is a grant project ordinance concerning a New Freedom grant funds, as described in the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Organization (DCHC MPO_ Coordinated Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Plan, Program Management Plan and DATA and Chapel Hill Transit JARC projects, and will be valid until completion of the grant projects or funds are expended.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive New Freedom grant funds for New Freedom approved projects. The New Freedom grant funding will be used in conjunction with financing allocated within the state/federal match budget of the Transportation Division.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to Complete the project:

Section 4. The following amount is appropriated for the project:

City of Durham	\$	14,331
Durham Area Transit Authority	\$	131,226
Durham Senior Life Center	\$	30,000
TOTAL	\$	<u>175,557</u>

Section 5. The grant match to be provided by the Durham Senior Life Center is reflected in this ordinance.

Section 6. This GPO supersedes GPO # 14532.

Section 7. Within five days after the adoption, the City shall file a copy of this Ordinance with the Budget Director, Director of Finance, Accounting Services Manager and the Transportation Planning Manager. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.
