

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING CIP PROJECT RELATED FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION FUNDING FROM THE NC DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING SIDEWALKS ALONG FAYETTEVILLE STREET GRANT PROJECT RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Durham anticipates receiving a grant from the Federal Highway Administration, through the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT), for constructing a sidewalk on the east side of Fayetteville Street between Cornwallis Road and Pilot Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The construction of sidewalks, as described in the grant agreement between the City and NCDOT, is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is complete. The project shall be completed within 18 months of the execution of the grant agreement. All invoices must be submitted to NCDOT for reimbursement no later than six months after the completion of construction and acceptance of the project.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the grant and to undertake the project.

Section 3. This resolution accepts the grant and authorizes the execution of the grant agreement and other documents. This resolution does not appropriate the grant funds. The grant funds are appropriated in the FY 2014-15 General Capital Improvement Project Ordinance.

Section 4. In addition to revenue previously made available for the project, the following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:

Federal Funds through NCDOT for sidewalk construction:	\$200,800
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Required City Funding: Federal/State Match CIP Project:	50,200
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Section 5. The following amount will be appropriated in the FY 2014-15 General Capital Improvement Project Ordinance to fund the project:

Federal Funds with Required City Funding:	\$251,000
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Section 6. Within five days after this ordinance is adopted, the City Clerk shall file a copy of this resolution with the Finance Director, Accounting Services Manager, and the Budget Director.
