RE: Internal Affairs Quarterly Report (July-September, 2014)

Overview:

The Durham Police Department, which consists of 512 sworn officer positions and 120 non-sworn positions, provides 24-hour law enforcement services to over 240,000 citizens of Durham.

During the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2014, Durham Police officers responded to over 95,000 service calls and served/engaged with 91,229 citizens. During the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2014 the Professional Standards Division received a total of 42 complaints/investigations. Thus, .05% of all citizen contacts during this quarter produced an investigation of an officer for any reason. Listed below is a breakdown of the complaints/investigations by type of investigation, violation alleged and disposition of the case.
