

**U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, 2014 BYRNE
CRIMINAL JUSTICE INNOVATION: PLANNING GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham, through the Durham Police Department, has been awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (USDOJ/BJA), in the amount of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant must be used to support data-driven, cross-sector strategies to reduce crime and violence, for target neighborhoods with hot spots of violent and serious crime; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The grant project described in the USDOJ/BJA's 2014 Byrne Criminal Justice Innovation: Planning grant application is hereby authorized to be undertaken during the grant period October 1, 2014 through March 31, 2016 or until all funds are expended.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the USDOJ/BJA's 2014 Byrne Criminal Justice Innovation: Planning grant and to undertake the project.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:
