2013 STOP/SEARCH RECAP

During 2013 a total of **25,630** traffic stops were conducted and of that number **2,103** people were searched, including drivers and passengers.

The racial breakdown follows; **362** white and **1,741** black. The chances of being searched during a stop are **1.4%** for white and **6.8%** for black.

Breakdown by race/sex; **B/M 5.4%, W/M 1.1%, B/F 1.4% and W/F .3%**

Of the drivers searched 1% were white and 4% were black. Of the total searches 60% were consent, 31% were probable cause, 6% were protective frisk and 3% were incident to arrest. No search warrant incidents were noted during 2013.
