

**UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE  
TEXT AMENDMENT CONSISTENCY STATEMENT  
BY THE DURHAM CITY COUNCIL  
REGARDING TC1400002, Industrial Light (IL) Project Boundary Buffers**

**Whereas** the Durham City Council, upon acting upon a text amendment to the *Unified Development Ordinance* and pursuant to NCGS § 160A-383, is required to approve a statement describing how the action is consistent with the *Durham Comprehensive Plan*; and

**Whereas** the Durham City Council, upon acting upon a text amendment to the *Unified Development Ordinance* and pursuant to NCGS § 160A-383, is required to provide a brief statement indicating how the action is reasonable and in the public interest.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ADOPTED BY THE DURHAM CITY COUNCIL AS APPROPRIATE:**

**IN THE EVENT THAT THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE ORDINANCE IS ADOPTED,**

That final action regarding text amendment TC1400002, Industrial Light (IL) Project Boundary Buffers, is based upon review of, and consistency with, the *Durham Comprehensive Plan* and any other officially adopted plan that is applicable, as provided in the "Issues" section of the memo to the City Manager, dated November 3, 2014, regarding the subject "*Unified Development Ordinance Text Amendment, Industrial Light (IL) Project Boundary Buffer (TC1400002),*" along with additional agenda information provided to the City Council and information provided at the public hearing; and

It is the objective of the Durham City Council to have the *Unified Development Ordinance* promote regulatory efficiency and consistency and the health, safety, and general welfare of the community.
