

SCHEDULE B1: RECOMMENDED

Defined Durham Workforce Development Board Structure under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

The defined Board structure of 25 members may be apportioned as follows:

- 51% business representatives (13) – A simple majority to be approved by the City with the remainder by the County
- 20% representatives of the workforce consisting of the following representatives:
 - 2 Labor Organizations, if they exist (1 City, 1 County)
 - 1 Apprenticeship Program (City)
 - 1 Community-Based Organization, either veterans or individuals with disabilities (County)
 - 1 Organization for Out-of-School Youth (City)
 - 1 Local Education Agency (City)
- 1 State Employment Service (City);
- 1 Economic Development – Chamber of Commerce/NCIMED (County)
- 1 Vocational Rehabilitation (County)
- 1 Higher Education/NCCU (City)
- 1 Adult Education & Literacy (City)
- 1 Agency that serves people with barriers to employment

Each elected body may appoint two (2) non-voting government body liaisons.
