Subject: 2014 Historic Preservation Commission CLG Annual Report

Summary. The Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) is required by the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement to submit an annual report to the Governing Bodies. Their 2014 report is attached.

Recommendation. Planning staff recommends that the City Council receive the Historic Preservation Commission Annual Report.

Background. The City and County of Durham, as part of their Certified Local Government (CLG) status, are required annually to submit a report on the activities of the Historic Preservation Commission to the State Historic Preservation Office. Since the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Historic Preservation Commission also requires an annual report, typically the CLG Annual Report has doubled as the annual report submitted to the City and County.
