

**THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA (UNC) AT CHAPEL HILL REQUEST FOR
TEMPORARY LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE, 2015 UNC CHAPEL HILL MUTUAL
AID GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE**

Whereas, the City of Durham agrees to provide temporary law enforcement assistance to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill on Sunday, October 25, 2015; and

Whereas, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill will reimburse the City of Durham for its overtime costs, including applicable benefits, for officers providing the requested law enforcement assistance; and

Whereas, funds received will be used to reimburse the City of Durham's overtime accounts; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The project described in the agreement with the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City of Durham to receive reimbursement for providing temporary law enforcement services by the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be reimbursed to the City of Durham for its assistance in this project. Town of Chapel Hill – \$11,820.26

Section 4. The following amount is appropriated for this project to be spent in the following manner:
