

SUBJECT: Case Z1400027 – Guglhupf Parking Expansion

The Durham Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission (BPAC) reviewed the project referenced above. We believe the project would better serve the needs of the community if the following items were included:

1. Add text commitment on the development plan to provide an accessible pedestrian connection between Francis Street and the existing or proposed parking lot for Guglhupf, subject to approval by the City of Durham, to be addressed during the site plan approval process.
2. Add text commitment on the development plan to provide bicycle parking on the existing Guglhupf site that meets Durham Unified Development Ordinance standards, to be addressed during the site plan approval process.

Below is a photo of the existing pedestrian connection between Francis Street and the Guglhupf site. This primitive connection is not accessible to those with disabilities and also does not work well with strollers or bicycles.
