

**2015 POLICE SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS/UNITS SPECIAL REVENUE FUND
PROJECT ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the City of Durham, through the Durham Police Department, anticipate to receive annual donations in the amount of \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the funds received must be used to support the Mental Health Outreach Program (MHOP), K-9 Unit, Victim Assistance, Citizens Police Academy, Honor Guard, Motor Unit, and the Police Explorers Program and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that:

Section 1. The special revenue fund project is authorized to support the MHOP, K-9 Unit, Victim Assistance, Citizens Police Academy, Honor Guard, Motor Unit, and the Police Explorers Program and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute any documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive the Police Specialized Programs/Units Special Revenue Fund and to undertake the project.

Section 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete this project:
