

CITY OF DURHAM AND US DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION- FEDERAL TRANSIT
ADMINISTRATION- SECTION 5317, NEW FREEDOM (NF) FUNDS GRANT PROJECT
ORDINANCE SUPERSEDING GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE #14266 AND AUTHORIZATION TO
EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Durham has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for the New Freedom (NF); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Durham deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking of City staff;

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 13.2 OF CHAPTER 159 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM that,

Section 1. The ordinance is a grant project ordinance concerning the NF grant funds, as described in the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO) Coordinated Public: Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan, Program Management Plan as well as in project applications submitted by DATA , Chapel Hill Transit and Durham Coordinating Council for Senior Citizens (DCCSC), and will be valid until completion of the grant projects or funds are expended.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the City to receive JARC funds project. The NF Grant funding will be used in conjunction with financing allocated within the state/federal match budget of the Transportation Department.

Section 3. The following revenue is anticipated to be available to the City of Durham to complete the project:

Section 5. This Grant Project Ordinance supersedes Ordinance # 14266.

Section 6. Within five days after the adoption, the City shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Budget Director, Director of Finance, Accounting Services Manager, and the Transportation Planning Manager. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
