Public Safety	An assessment of police staffing is currently being performed by the DPD. Ensure that all appropriate data is collected and analyzed in a thorough manner. Utilize comparisons with national best practices and similarly sized NC cities. Ensure consideration is incorporated in the process to address PRI citizen survey response concerns regarding community policing, i.e. the need for more “face time” and relationship building with individual officers through foot/bike/Segway patrols in the target zone, beat officer presence at community functions and events, solicitation of and response to community concerns through regular dialogue, etc. (Adequate Staffing Action Plan)	2/1/2015	4/1/15
