

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DURHAM CITY CODE SECTION 26-146 BY
INCREASING VALUE OF A JUNKED MOTOR VEHICLE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURHAM:

New text is underlined and deleted text is struck out:

Section 1: Durham City Code Section 26-146 entitled “Definitions” presently defines “junked motor vehicle” as follows:

Junked motor vehicle means a vehicle that does not display a current and valid license plate lawfully upon that vehicle and that:

- (1) Is partially dismantled or wrecked; or
- (2) Cannot be self-propelled or moved in the manner which it originally was intended to move; or
- (3) Is more than five years old and ~~appears to be worth less than \$100.00.~~

The above definition is repealed and REWRITTEN as follows:

Junked motor vehicle means a vehicle that does not display a current and valid license plate lawfully upon that vehicle and that:

- (1) Is partially dismantled or wrecked; or
- (2) Cannot be self-propelled or moved in the manner which it originally was intended to move; or
- (3) Is more than five years old and appears to be worth less than \$500.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage.
