Dear Sam and Amanda Derr,

You are hereby notified that you are violating the Rules adopted by the North Carolina Commission for Health Services, Article 11 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes of North Carolina; or Permit Conditions by owning or controlling a residence, place of business, or place of public assembly which is not provided with an approved wastewater system. Your wastewater system is not in compliance.

An inspection of the wastewater system at above referenced property by the Durham County Department of Public Health indicated the following violations:

You are hereby ordered to bring your wastewater system into compliance by completing the following:

Make application with Public Works to connect to municipal sewer by calling 919-560-4326.


Or

You may choose to vacate the residence and properly abandon the plumbing.

If the wastewater violation is not brought into compliance by June 20, 2016, appropriate legal action will be taken.

Failure to comply with the laws, rules, and this notice will subject you to the following legal remedies; Injunction Relief [G.S. 130A-18], Administrative Penalties [G.S. 130-22(c)], Suspension or Revocation of Permits [G.S. 130-23], and Criminal Penalties [G.S. 130-25].
