

## Summary of Fees for Underground Utility Installation

### As of Date of Adoption (March 8, 2016)

- For permits to install 5,280 linear feet of infrastructure or less, the existing fee schedule (which was adopted in 2010) will remain.

<b><i>Tiered Schedule (in linear feet of installation)</i></b>	<b><i>Fee Structure</i></b>
200 feet or less	\$50
Over 200 feet, up to 1,000 feet	\$120
Over 1,000 feet, up to 5,000 feet	\$460
Over 5,000 feet, Calculate per above rates	Additive for above rates (ex. 5,150 lf = \$510)

- For permits to install greater than 5,280 linear feet of infrastructure, a new fee schedule will apply which represents fifty percent cost recovery based on the city's contract with a private firm.

### As of July 01, 2016

As of July 01, 2016, for permits to install infrastructure in the public rights of way, the following fees will apply.

- For permits to install 5,280 linear feet of infrastructure or less, the will be calculated to achieve fifty percent cost recovery based on an analysis of internal staff costs associated with permit review and inspection.
- For permits to install greater than 5,280 linear feet of infrastructure the consultant who will review, process and inspect all permits for installation of infrastructure greater than 5,280 linear feet will continue to track actual expenses for the permitted work. Staff will use this data to determine the accuracy of the rate structure and is prepared to adjust the rates annually to achieve a fifty percent cost recovery goal.

### Re-inspection Fee

The following fees will become effective as of the adoption of the ordinance establishing certain fees for underground utility installations (March 8, 2016). The re-inspection fee will apply to all permits, regardless of the proposed length of the installation.

- A fee of \$325 per occurrence will be applied for each instance of re-inspection.
- A fee of three times the value of the initial permit will be issued for each instance for failure to obtain a permit.
