

## Definitions

**Debris Monitor**: Debris monitors serve as the Owner's field representatives. They ensure that the terms and specific monitoring and documentation requirements of debris removal contracts are adhered to and met. For force account debris removal operations, debris monitors ensure that the debris removal operations are efficient, safe, and properly documented to substantiate the applicant's grant claim.

**Debris Management Sites (DMS)**: A DMS is a location for Owner's to temporarily store, reduce, segregate, and/or process debris before it is hauled to its final disposition. It is frequently used to increase the operational flexibility when landfill space is limited or when the landfill is not in close proximity to the debris removal area.
