- Durham received a \$40 million Choice Neighborhoods Initiative grant from HUD and Mr. Johnson's team had an event today that included the public and national and regional HUD leadership
 - Grant funds will go towards building housing sites, as well as programming and resources for residents
 - The City and DHA are partners and co-applicants on the grant, and multiple City departments will be involved in the grant implementation process
