



## DURHAM CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF VIRTUAL REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS AND WORK SESSIONS

Because of the risks to the public that would arise from continued in-person meetings, the City is converting regular City Council meetings and Work Sessions to a ***virtual format*** for the duration of the North Carolina and City of Durham States of Emergency.

This complies with the State of North Carolina, Durham County, and the City of Durham State of Emergency Declarations in response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus). Governor Roy Cooper has also issued Executive Orders 117, 118 and 121, which impose restrictions intended to slow the spread of COVID-19, which includes limiting large events and gatherings of more than 10 people.
