



The State of North Carolina, Durham County, and the City of Durham have all declared States of Emergency in response to the COVID-19 virus. Because of the risks to the public that would arise from continued in person meetings, the City is converting Board of Adjustment meetings to a remote electronic format for the time being.

The Durham Board of Adjustment will hold a VIRTUAL public meeting on May 26, 2020, at 8:30 a.m. This meeting will include a vote on orders for two cases that have already gone through the public hearing process:

- B1700052 – Discovery Charter II Minor Special Use Permit
