Durham Mayor to Award Dr. Mandy Cohen Key to the City *Virtual Ceremony to be Livestreamed January 19*

DURHAM, N.C. – During a virtual ceremony later this evening, City of Durham Mayor Steve Schewel will acknowledge [Dr. Mandy Cohen](#), secretary of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, for her extraordinary service to the Bull City and the state during the global COVID-19 pandemic.
