Total Referrals & Outcomes

42 individuals referred

- 38 participants completed the program
- 4 participants were still enrolled on June 30th, 2016

Referral Source

- 35 referrals from Durham Police Department (community-based law enforcement officers)
- 7 referrals from Durham County Sheriff's Office (school resource officers)

Demographics of Program Participants

Gender

- Female: 24 participants
- Male: 18 participants

Ethnicity

- African-American: 23 participants
- White: 14 participants
- Hispanic/Latino: 5 participants

Education/Employment

- 21 college students (3 in community college, 18 in a 4-year university)
- 14 high school students
- 6 high school graduates working full-time
- 1 non-graduate working

- Leadership Skills Group: 8
- Independent Living Skills Group or Therapy: 11
