Portion of Piney Wood Park Temporarily Closed During the Day for Maintenance

DURHAM, NC - On November 28 through early December, the large dog park area in Piney Wood Park, 400 E. Woodcroft Parkway, will be closed during the day for maintenance. The area will still be available for play before 8 a.m. and after 3 p.m. The small dog area will remain open for small dogs only.

Maintenance will include the clearing of tree limbs and vines from the fence areas, and removal of invasive plant undergrowth within the large dog area. The muddy area along the back fence of the large dog park area will also be filled with rock screenings. This work is being done to increase visibility and deter criminal behavior as specified in the Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) guidelines.

During the closure, patrons with large dogs can use the Downtown Durham Dog Park, 304 Elliott Street, and/or Northgate Dog Park, 400 W Lavender Avenue. Check the DPRPlayMore.org for updates.
