## **NCWorks Career Center at Briggs Temporarily Closes for Renovations**

*Center Will Close at Noon on December 8 and All Day on December 11*

DURHAM, N.C. – The [NCWorks Career Center Durham at Briggs](#) will close at noon on Friday, December 8 and will remain closed on Monday, December 11 for renovations.

During this time, the Center will undergo a \$50,000 makeover to include new paint, new carpet, and new workstations. The Center will re-open at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, December 12.

The Center is using Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds for the renovation project, which are passed through the N.C. Division of Workforce Solutions from the U.S. Department of Labor.
