

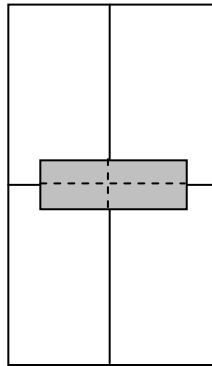


City of Durham, Cemeteries Division “Community Monument Grave Package”



At both City owned cemeteries, the City Ordinance requires that in order to erect a family upright monument, a customer must own a minimum of a four grave lot in a designated area that allows upright monuments.

As a new concept, we recognize that not all families have the need for four grave spaces and have developed the Community Monument Package. This package meets the needs of customers who wish to have their name information placed on an upright monument, but do not have the need to purchase four grave spaces, further allowing them to share the cost of the four grave lot, foundation and monument with others who have the same need. Each monument is placed in the center of the four grave spaces, and each grave space has interest in a quarter of the upright monument (seen in the diagram below).



Community Monument Grave Package Cost

To determine the price for Community Packages, we have taken the cost of a 4 grave lot (\$5,600.00), added the fee for the Upright Monument, and it's foundation and simply divided the cost by four.

Our Current cost for the Community package is: \$2,310.00

Cost if Purchased Separately by the Customer

In any other section, a minimum of four graves is required to have an upright monument (\$1,400.00 per grave X 4 = \$5,600.00).

Foundation fees are charged per square foot of concrete, all foundations are required to be four feet deep. An average monument base is about 12" X 5' and cost roughly \$350.00).

An upright monument for a basic four grave Monument Lot can be no larger than 14" x 5' (base) and an estimated cost would be \$2,000.00-\$4,000.00 depending on material and style.
