June 26, 2018 Resolution on Anti-Semitism:

Durham is a city that celebrates its great diversity of origins. The Durham Human Relations Commission strongly condemns both the anti-Semitic comments made by a resident at the Durham city council meeting (4/16/18) and anti-Semitic posters distributed throughout downtown Durham (5/1/18) that perpetuate false and harmful stereotypes. Expressions of anti-Semitism in any form are hate speech, designed to create a climate of fear in the Jewish community. We believe that people of all and no religious beliefs must be respected and embraced. The City Human Relations Commission stands against bigotry and injustice.
