Dear Resident:

The Public Works Department is pleased to announce that pre-construction activities for ST-264, Fayetteville Road Improvements, are proceeding toward conclusion. Following successful execution of the contract construction is currently scheduled to begin in March of 2019. This will be an 18-month project. The City is preparing to award a contract for construction to Carolina Sunrock LLC of Raleigh, NC, in the amount of \$10,561,031.21. Please be aware that City Council is scheduled to discuss the project at its Work Session meeting at 1:00 PM on November 20 and the City Council Meeting at 7:00 PM on December 3, 2018. These meetings are open to the public and are an opportunity for all residents to discuss the project or related topics with Councilmembers.

The ST-264, Fayetteville Road Improvements project is the combination of the Fayetteville Buxton Riddle Realignment project and the Fayetteville Road Widening project. The combined project will widen and enhance Fayetteville Road from Riddle Road south to Barbee Road, approximately one mile. Buxton and Riddle Roads will be realigned from the current configuration into a traditional intersection. Cornwallis and Barbee Roads and a portion of the American Tobacco Trail will have their intersection geometry improved. Pedestrian enhancements include sidewalk and bicycle lanes on both sides of the road. After construction improvements, Fayetteville Road will feature a minimum four-lane divided cross section with upgrades to the curb and gutter, drainage, median islands, and traffic signals.
