**Project: New Hope Creek and Little Creek Watershed Improvement Plan | SP-2019-01**

**Public Notice**

The City of Durham is seeking a qualified engineering firm to develop a watershed improvement plan for the New Hope Creek and Little Creek watersheds in the City of Durham. This watershed improvement plan is to include evaluation of Sandy Creek, Mud Creek, and lower New Hope Creek subwatersheds (the greater New Hope Watershed) and the Little Creek watershed, which together compose the New Hope Arm of B. Everett Jordan Lake watershed in Durham County. Work will include assessment of current watershed conditions, conducting public meetings and other outreach, formulation of watershed restoration goals, development of watershed restoration recommendations and plans, identification of stormwater retrofit and stream restoration opportunities, water quality modeling, watershed modeling, hydraulic/hydrologic modeling, engineering, design, analysis, cost estimates, surveying, data collection, and preliminary plans and construction plans for stormwater projects.
