Open House for Buchanan Boulevard Waterline Replacement Project

Public Invited to Informal Meet & Greet, Q&A with Project Officials

DURHAM, N.C. – In an effort to provide information and answer questions about an upcoming waterline replacement project, the City of Durham Department of Water Management will host an open house on Tuesday, December 4 at Healthy Start Academy at 807 West Chapel Hill Street. Area residents are encouraged to stop by the school gymnasium between 5:00 and 7:00 p.m. to learn more about upcoming work, and meet employees from Water Management and its project partners. Comments and questions are welcomed and appreciated. There will be breakout sessions, project posters, and other resources detailing the project. Comment cards and sign-up sheets will also be available to guests interested in additional information. This is an informal event, and guests may attend at any time during the two hours.

About the Project

The Department of Water Management is improving the existing water infrastructure along sections of Buchanan Boulevard. The locations of the improvements can be viewed on the project area map available online at <http://durhamnc.gov/3617/Buchanan-Blvd-Waterline-Replacement>. The Study/Design phase, geotechnical borings, and Level A subsurface utility engineering are complete. Construction is expected to begin in January 2019 and last approximately nine months.
