## City of Durham Contains Sewer Spill at Cedar Creek Pump Station

DURHAM, N.C. – The City of Durham Department of Water Management reports that on January 13, 2019, approximately 50 gallons of wastewater overflowed from the Cedar Creek Pump Station into an unnamed tributary that flows into Eno River.

The overflow occurred at approximately 10:45 a.m. It was caused by an electrical issue, and ended at approximately 10:55 a.m. The surrounding area has been remediated and there are no immediately visible adverse environmental impacts or hazards to persons or property.
