Virtual Meeting Details Forthcoming

A virtual public hearing will be held by the Durham City Council to receive citizen comments on the Draft 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan, and Draft Amended Citizen Participation Plan. The Consolidated/Annual Action Plan specifies how the City of Durham will address housing and community needs for the next five years through the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) Consortium funds, Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds, and Housing Opportunities for People With AIDS funds (HOPWA). For FY 2020-2021, the City of Durham anticipates receiving \$2,044,310 in CDBG funds, \$1,165,206 in HOME Consortium funds, \$174,691 in ESG funds, and \$483,344 in HOPWA funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The purpose of the Citizen Participation Plan is to provide guidelines for the public engagement process that will be followed to ensure that citizens are given reasonable opportunity to participate concerning HUD grant funds.

The Draft 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan, and Draft Amended Citizen Participation Plan will be available for public review from May 22, 2020 - June 22, 2020 on the Community Development Department website located at <http://durhamnc.gov/445/Community-Development>. A virtual City Council meeting is scheduled in lieu of an in-person meeting, instructions for online participation will be posted on this website at a later date.
