



City of Durham On-Site Employee COVID-19 Testing

To use the City of Durham’s on-site employee COVID-19 testing option, employees must:

- A. *Fall into one of the priority testing categories detailed below, **and***
- B. *Schedule an appointment using the [CVS Health® Online Scheduling System](#).*

The City of Durham and CVS Health® require appointments to ensure adequate resource availability.

Priority Testing Categories

- **Category 1:** Mandatory Testing
 - Employees participating in the mandatory testing program must [schedule an appointment](#) at the City’s CVS Health® on-site clinic or use a [No Cost Testing Site](#).
- **Category 2:** Directed by HR
 - HR reserves the right to direct any employee to use the City's on-site testing option. In order to test on-site, employees who are not part of the mandatory testing program must provide email proof from HR to CVS at the time of testing.

If you do not fall in one of the above categories, you should schedule at an outside testing facility (e.g., CVS Health® retail location, other pharmacy location, doctor’s office, etc.) or use a [No Cost Testing Site](#).

If eligible, based on the criteria above, you can access on-site COVID-19 testing at the following location:
