### **ST-322: PUBLIC WORKS – MARYLAND AVE. BRIDGE REMOVAL**

The City of Durham will open formal sealed bids and electronic password protected bids in PDF format submitted by bidders at **2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, May 10, 2022** for Contract **ST-322: Maryland Ave. Bridge Removal**, via ZOOM meeting. This project involves the removal of one municipally-owned bridge located in the City of Durham, as well as stream restoration, storm sewer repair, and erosion control. The work to be performed includes but is not limited to the removal of the existing Bridge No. 310233, grading of existing channel side slopes, installation stream bank restoration devices and erosion control measures, repairs to adjacent storm sewer networks, and replacement of existing aerial utility support piers and installation of utility encasement pipe.
